re-selected as candidate for May's elections

Councillor Graeme Campbell has been re-selected as the Scottish Conservatives' candidate for Avondale & Stonehouse Ward in the council elections in May.

After his selection Graeme said "It has been a privilege to represent the people of Avondale over the last two council terms and with their support: I hope to represent this fantastic community for another 5 years," Graeme Campbell has been a councillor in South Lanarkshire (Ward-5: "Avondale & Stonehouse") since 2007.

GRAEME CAMPBELL'S LOCAL PRIORITIES:

Strathaven: Far too many low income families are living in poverty because they cannot gain access to good quality social housing. With the waiting list for a council house in Strathaven running at nearly 20 years and all the planning gain money from the new housing developments in Strathaven going to fund social housing projects in East Kilbride and Hamilton; Graeme has made it clear he is focusing on changing this policy.

Stonehouse: The people of Stonehouse want access to better facilities and potentially even a secondary school. For 2 terms now, Graeme has been one of the few councillors supporting the development of Stonehouse and if re-elected in 2017: Graeme will work hard to deliver new developments in the village, which can fund the facilities this fantastic community wants.

Avondale: Roads remain one of Graeme's top priorities! In the last two terms, Graeme has overseen more than £10m in highway improvements across Avondale but he is very aware that roads and footpaths require even more investment.



Despite promising it would be a "once in a generation" decision, it didn't take long for the SNP to start campaigning for a second referendum on independence.

So the Council elections in May will be an important opportunity for you to tell the SNP – we voted No to independence, so respect the result and don't put us through it all again.

It's vital there are strong voices across Scotland prepared to stand up against them and their divisive plans.

We said No to independence. Use your vote for the Scottish Conservative and Unionist Party to tell the SNP we meant it.
